We are beginning to look at fund raisers for next season. Please let a Board member or myself know if you have any ideas for fund raisers for the start of the season.

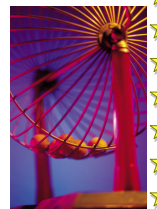


Lottery Calendars - Mike Petta

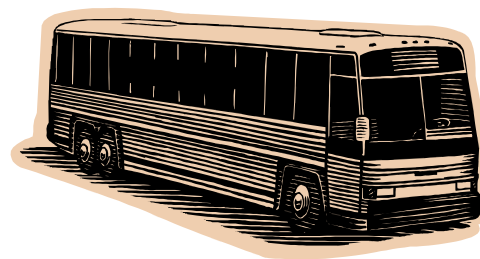

\$5.00 per person will cover the cost of the hamburgers, hot dogs and sodas. Please bring a dish to pass.

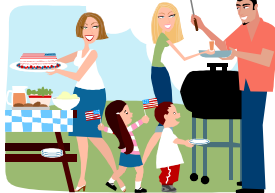
This shelter is on the trail along the river. ***Remember the shelter name is Riverbend!***

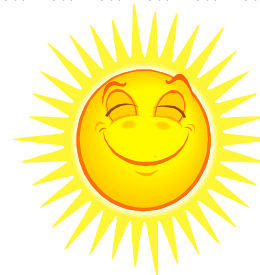
