A five game losing streak that didn't reflect the season's play was broken on the 16th when the Amerks (7th place in the league) had their biggest offensive night in over three decades, with a 12-3 victory over the Penguins (3rd place in the league), marking the Penguin's biggest deficit in their franchise history. What an exciting night that was! This was also the most goals scored by the Amerks since 1985, when they defeated St. Catherine's 13 to 3 on April 7th, and the most goals scored by an AHL team since the Hamilton Bulldogs 15 to 1 win over the Cleveland Barons on Dec. 8, 2002.
